

UNDER THE AFRICAN SUN

Silhouettes of African animals in the sunset – this is where master engraver Stefano Pedretti demonstrates his artistic skills. Rhino, lion, elephant, cape buffalo, zebra and leopard seem close enough to touch because of their photo-realistic visual representation in the classic Bulino style. The warm yellow tone made of solid fine gold underlines the unique lighting atmosphere. On the bolt housing and the bottom, sweeping arabesques and filigree gold inlays with bluing create an exciting interplay. A special eye-catcher is the bolt handle ball. Delicately engraved, it boasts gold inlays and impresses with its radiant, half-carat gemstone.

The highly polished barrel and the contrasting grade 11 root wood of the stock give this rifle an extraordinary frame.





R8 “THE SOUTHERN TRAPPER”

A full leathered homage to the southern states of the USA:
The leather that we use for the R8 “The Southern Trapper”
comes from the Alligator mississippiensis in South Carolina.

The animals are not bred on an alligator farm for leather production, but hunted sustainably in the wild. The hunting and closed season on the alligator is specified by the individual states themselves to prevent overpopulation. Every alligator leather we use in the Blaser Custom Shop has of course appropriate CITES documents.

The stock leathering is made with the so called back cut. This leaves the softer and finer belly leather of the alligator as a whole. Only this leather finds application in full leathering.

ALL IN LEATHER

Leather is a natural material that can be used in many ways. And with good reason, as even today it is in a league of its own in terms of durability and feel. So it's no wonder leather has established a solid position in the hunting rifle-sector, too.

Who hasn't experienced the pleasant feeling of running your fingers around your car's leather steering wheel? Who cannot appreciate the robustness of hand-made mountain boots or leather trousers that last for generations? So why not make the stocks of hunting rifles out of this elegant material, too? Especially as more and more hunters choose the technical superiority of synthetic stocks but also want a traditional look for their rifle. A whole range of leather types are perfect for this usage. Whether you opt for buffalo, red deer or even ostrich leather, each of their textures provide an extremely comfortable grip and their colors, an eminently attractive look. Top-quality English cowhide is used in the Blaser Custom Shop's newest creation. This material would otherwise mainly be used for exclusive saddles in equestrian sports. The fully leather-clad R8 Professional Success "Leather" becomes almost indestructible and extremely weatherproof, making it a coveted bolt action rifle for those who hunt on horseback and for all fans of unusual yet practical hunting rifles.



Covers for the stock are cut by hand out of extravagantly preprocessed English cowhide using templates.

The sewing of the stock's leather cover is done exclusively by hand. Experience plus dexterity with leather, needles and thread are required here.

Besides its elegant look, stingray leather surpasses all other types of leather by far in terms of its tear and friction resistance! The leather of the stingray used in the Blaser Custom Shop is a by-product of edible fish extraction and is therefore not subject to species protection.

From traditional to high tech: Besides classic engravings, we also offer numerous options of surface finishing – whether a high-gloss finish with Diamond-Like-Carbon coating on the trigger and bolt handle ball, the stylish custom case hardening in combination with elegant burl wood, or the exclusive coating of the receiver with a Ruthenium finish – one of the rarest precious metals in the world.

The following coatings are possible:

Steel: DLC (Diamond like Carbon), Ruthenium finish, custom case hardening, gold plating, titanium nitriding, plasma nitriding (brushed, blasted, polished, burnished)

Aluminum: DLC (Diamond like Carbon), Ruthenium finish, gold plating, anodizing (gold colored, steel gray, black, gray)




LASER ENGRAVINGS OF THE THIRD DIMENSION

It is a machine that was not actually developed for the manufacturing of hunting firearms, but for the automotive industry, that is used today to create highly individual laser engravings that are unparalleled in terms of detail and depth.

The removal of different layers not only creates depth in the image, but also the extraordinary feel of the processed parts. In the process, we are always pushing the limits – the tiny, razor-sharp elements that the laser engraves are sometimes only up to 1 mm thick.

Manual labor is nevertheless required for laser engraving. In the Blaser Custom Shop, master engraver Ralph Salzmann prepares and creates the image files for the laser by hand. This is done in initial sketches quite traditionally with paper and pencil, and later they are digitized on the drawing tablet.



In doing so, even relief-like representations are possible now. However, Ralph Salzmann has to "think" his way into every engraving from scratch in order to be able to create the different depths digitally. This is where his more than 20 years of experience as an engraver come in handy: he knows exactly what the engraving has to look like in the end.

Before production can begin, the image file must be prepared for the laser. To do this, it is divided into the three layers: Background, dithering (rasterization into dots) and grayscale. This usually takes much longer than the production on the machine itself.

From sculpted lion head to portrait photo of a dog up to textured alligator skin and geometric shapes: Laser technology can be used to reproduce anything that can be created digitally. Motifs become possible that previously would have been very time-intensive and difficult for the engraver to realize and with a very high time and thus very expensive for the customer.

In the Blaser Custom Shop, we are excited about the new possibilities that laser technology presents for the refinement of hunting rifles.

Ralph Salzmänn is artisan and hand craftsman, advisor and spin doctor, illustrator and perfectionist. He is only satisfied when, with only a few strokes, he has given the impression that he has engraved thousands of blades of grass from the African veldt onto a bolt housing. He has mastered the art of reductionism. He has done this for the last 20 years, and during this time he has developed a distinctive style that is recognizable to experts in the field. He is the man for endowing almost magical emotions to the firearm. Could it be that, in his own way, he really has become a magician?



LAPPING

At Blaser, we are always striving to push the boundaries of precision. The already outstanding inherent accuracy of Blaser hammered barrels is perfected by manual lapping. This special technique makes it possible to eliminate tiny irregularities and microstructures that are barely visible even to the naked eye. By carefully polishing and smoothing the barrel, we create a near-perfect internal surface.

The effects on the shot grouping are impressive. The lapping process creates exceptional uniformity of the bullet trajectory while minimizing the shot groups. By lapping the rifle's barrel we go to a remarkably new level. The famous thumbnail as a measure of shot group can now also be achieved with calibers and bullets that were previously limited with factory loads.

If you are looking for the ultimate shooting experience while offering you unsurpassed accuracy, a Blaser rifle barrel lapped with the highest precision is essential.

MUZZLES

Different muzzle shapes or attachments, such as a muzzle brake, affect recoil, shooting accuracy and overall performance of the firearm.

An effective muzzle shape, such as a tapered muzzle, or a muzzle brake can reduce recoil, resulting in improved stability and accuracy when shooting. Muzzle rise and barrel oscillation are minimized by selectively diverting gases or altering the ejection pattern of the projectile.

Furthermore, the shape of the muzzle can also affect shooting accuracy. For example, a well-designed muzzle can reduce swirl or turbulence in the airflow at the end of the barrel, resulting in a more stable trajectory of the projectile. This, in turn, allows for more accurate hits and smaller shot groups.

For the precision-oriented shooter, it is important to understand the various muzzle designs and their effects in order to make the optimal choice for his or her individual needs. Carefully matching the muzzle to the rifle can improve overall performance and provide an outstanding shooting experience.



TWIST RATES

The twist rate of a hunting rifle plays a decisive role in the effect and precision of a bullet. 



An adjusted twist rate also allows more efficient use of the bullet's kinetic energy, which increases stopping effectiveness during hunting.

Baffle design and geometry is the heart of every silencer. It is largely responsible for reducing the recoil – and in combination with the large volume of the silencer – reducing the sound of the shot and protecting a shooter's hearing. For the Blaser Integral Silencer (ISD), the geometry was optimized to the maximum diameter – while still maintaining the overall aesthetic of the rifle itself.



Within a fraction of a second – all the processes take place inside the silencer – which ensure recoil reduction and noise dampening when the shot is fired. As an example, with a barrel length of 42 cm (16.5") in .308 Win, the projectile emerges from the muzzle at a velocity of 750 m/s. It passes completely through the length of the Integral Silencer in just 0.27 milliseconds.

The muzzle brake deflects a part of the gases rearward, in an evenly dispersed fashion. Like the outer tube, the muzzle brake is made of titanium, which ensures minimum weight and optimum durability. It is also responsible for ensuring that the Blaser Integral Silencer can be properly attached to the muzzle thread of the barrel. This allows the bullet to pass through the silencer without obstruction. With this high-strength material and its precise manufacturing – the problems with bullet striations and the resulting change in the point of impact are now a thing of the past.

Both operating elements are made of sturdy metal. The rubber coating in handy fish-scale chequered design ensures a safe grip even in wet conditions.

RETICLE IN THE FIRST FOCAL PLANE: PERFECTLY PRECISE

The Blaser B1 riflescopes stand for perfect precision. No wonder then, that we have consistently relied on reticles in the first focal plane when developing this line of riflescopes.

With riflescopes featuring a reticle in the first focal plane, the point of impact cannot be changed when switching magnification due to their special design. The reticle overlays the target image before the moving parts of the zoom system come into play.

Originally, reticles in the first focal plane were the benchmark for European premium riflescopes because of their more reliable construction. Then, with the development of illuminated reticles for daytime use, many manufacturers switched their reticle to the second focal plane. At the time, the luminous structures could not be made fine enough to be integrated into the first focal plane.

Thanks to Swiss phase grating technology it was possible to design very fine reticles in the first focal plane featuring a reticle illumination that is also suitable for daylight. A benefit that we at Blaser simply had to make use of – for a constant point of impact with any magnification: The shot hits precisely where expected!

SAFETY WITH LONG-DISTANCE SHOTS

While hunting, there are situations in which a long-range shot may become necessary. All well and good, when you are able to remain on target and don't have to hold over. The Quick Distance Control (QDC) was specially developed for this purpose. Its highly precise and extremely robust mechanics provide a consistently reliable return to zero.

The Blaser riflescopes B1 2.8–20x50iC and B1 4–20x58iC come with QDC Quick Distance Control as a standard feature. Before shooting over long distances, the corresponding elevation correction of the fast reticle adjustment can be done comfortably even when already in shooting position. A unique feature allows you to fix the two adjustments “zeroed” and shooter chosen impact point (4 cm high with a rifle that is zeroed at 100 m). This prevents an unintentional adjustment.

If, due to a long shooting distance, 4 cm high at 100 m should not be sufficient, the reticle elevation adjustment can be rotated further by the necessary “number of clicks”. In this case, the adjustment is not locked by lowering the adjustment turret, so that its previously selected adjustments remain clearly visible and reminds you to later set back to your “zeroed position”.



AUTOMATICALLY LOCKED

The adjustment turret for parallax is automatically locked for a distance of approximately 100m. Thus, it cannot be adjusted unintentionally. Before shooting at distances greater than 100 m, the adjustment turret is easily pulled out to select the desired distance.

COMPLETING THE MACNAB WITH THE BOCKDRILLING

For Robin Marx, Head of Product Management at Blaser, it was a long-held dream to take on the Macnab Challenge in north-west Scotland. That he wanted to use his preferred hunting gun, the Blaser Bockdrilling BD14, instead of a shotgun and rifle made this trip even more exciting.

The Macnab Challenge has its roots in a novel from the 1920s. Fictional Scotsman John Macnab was in a life crisis and was looking for an unusual challenge. Most of his hunting activities until then had been of the illegal kind.

One day, he challenged the owner of a large estate with the statement that he would soon remove the quarry of a single hunting day and return it to the estate house undetected. Although this boastful statement probably involved plenty of whisky, John Macnab kept his promise and soon delivered a stag and a brace of grouse to the estate owner's door. He completed this impressive feat with a salmon that he had caught in the nearby river, with a fly he had made from deer hair.

The story of John Macnab remains popular to this day. It has encouraged many hunters to copy his efforts – legally this time – and accept the challenge of shooting a stag and a brace of grouse (two birds) and of also successfully fly fishing for a salmon.

Robin Marx did not want to be without his own BD14 for this challenge. After all, this firearm had already proven itself in its greatest test: Robin had achieved the result for the gold shooting pin in the special stage at his home range of the German Hunting Association (DJV). It was probably the first time that such an achievement had been completed with a combination gun. Robin's choice had only one disadvantage – the very time-consuming journey to Scotland due to the firearm.



As the German airline Lufthansa no longer permit hunting rifles to be transported to Great Britain, a long car journey to Amsterdam was required first. From there, KLM Airlines offer direct flights to several destinations in Scotland, including Edinburgh, the destination airport for this trip. This was followed by a four-hour car journey with a rental car on narrow roads and in left-hand traffic, which Robin was not used to, until he finally reached Ullapool on the north-west coast of Scotland. From this small harbour town, a daily ferry goes to the Isle of Lewis, home to the Garynahine Estate. This seemingly endless hunting estate was the starting point for Robin's first Macnab experience.

Guide Donnie was rather surprised and not exactly enthusiastic when he saw Robin's rifle. He disapproved of the idea of having to hunt grouse and stag with a German Drilling with two rifle barrels and only one shotgun barrel. At least he was able to dispel Robin's concerns about the weather: It would only be raining for hours at a time instead of all day long as usual. →





Quite in contrast to Donnie's weather forecast, it was pouring down the next day – the first hunting day. The strong gusts of wind sealed the deal: Donnie decided not to try for the mandatory stag on the morning of that day. While the chances were not too bad, Donnie's decision was understandable. Because what good would it have been to shoot a stag if the potential of the subsequent grouse hunt would have been very low?

On the morning of the second hunting day, the weather had improved significantly and Donnie stayed with his hunting strategy. As he probably still saw Robin's Bockdrilling with only one shotgun barrel as a big handicap, he wanted to try for grouse first, of which at least two are required according to the rules of the Macnab challenge.

Luckily, one of Donnie's two Pointers soon indicated the first grouse in the extensive grounds. As an experienced shotgun shooter, Robin had no problems hitting the bird as it was flying off. That was the first hurdle overcome and Donnie was pleasantly surprised.

That even a master shot can miss was proven half an hour later. Robin was most upset about not having been focused enough. Donnie, however, having by now realised that Robin was no beginner, encouraged him and assured him that they would soon encounter more grouse. Shortly after, Robin completed the first step of the challenge with ease.

Now he had to catch a salmon with a fly rod in the river only a few kilometres away. Not an easy task at that time of year, as the salmon move to their spawning grounds and usually no longer feed. To be successful, the fly had to be used expertly to trigger a bite reflex. There was an added complication, however, on the day when Robin tried for his Macnab. The strong rains of the past days had caused the river to swell so much that Donnie's optimism had waned noticeably. But he was experienced enough to know which type of line, trace and fly could be the only saving grace in this situation.



It would turn out to be Robin's greatest challenge of the day. Already thinking about the stags and knowing that he was under great time pressure, it was not easy to follow Donnie's advice on how to handle the line and rod correctly. Everyone was accordingly relieved when the first bite of the day occurred about three hours later and the salmon had been safely brought to the river bank with a landing net.

There was not much time for Robin and Donnie to enjoy the catch under these difficult circumstances. The sun would set in a good two hours and Robin had to shoot his stag before then. As it would have been impossible to walk the distance from the river into the more hilly region of the estate, where the red deer are, they took a short trip in the fourwheel drive car.

The subsequent stalk at the edge of a high-lying valley on damp, uneven terrain was very strenuous and took longer than Robin and Donnie would have liked. It was due to the still very good red deer population in this area that Donnie spotted a lone, older ten-pointer quite quickly. It all came down to the wire then for Ronnie, when Donnie told him to take the shot. After a seemingly endless few minutes, the long-awaited shot finally sounded through the valley. Donnie grabbed his binoculars. His smile signalled relief and appreciation. —





AROUND THE WORLD WITH THE 8,5x55 BLASER

Traveling the world and hunting with the 8,5x55 Blaser caliber is one of our video projects that has taken us from cold Norway to incredible Namibia. We have hunted in many countries before but doing so in Africa had long been a dream. After much planning, it finally became a reality.





Our excitement was palpable as our plane touched down on the tarmac at Namibia's Windhoek airport. After leaving a frigid, snowy Norway, we were embraced by a wave of welcome warm air. Soon thereafter, we were met by our guide who was waiting to take us to Blaser's Sney Rivier Lodge in the heart of the Namibian wilderness.

We reached the area after a two-hour drive and couldn't believe our eyes. The spots in the tree were unmistakable. A leopard! It could have taken days or weeks to see one.

We drove on for a few more minutes and received a warm welcome at the Blaser Sney Rivier Lodge. We had seen pictures of it, but this lodge is much more stunning in person. And luxurious. Truly beyond our expectations.

General Manager and Professional Hunter Conway Volek gave us a tour and introduced us to the staff who showed us our rooms and helped with luggage. Later, by the lunch table, the guides shared plans for us to visit the shooting range to check the rifles and assess our shooting skills. On this trip, we decided to leave our lovely Blaser R8 rifles at home. Our favorite caliber is 8,5x55 Blaser, and we knew they had a few Blaser R8 Silence rifles in 8,5x55 caliber at the lodge, so opted to borrow theirs which made our travels lighter and much easier.

After a few minutes drive through the bush, we came to the shooting ground and the fun began. We shot from 100m up to 400m from various positions – sitting from the table and standing using shooting sticks. As expected, the Blaser R8 Silence performed flawlessly.

The 8,5x55 Blaser is a solid caliber but with the Silence model, it was super comfortable and pleasurable to shoot. After burning some gunpowder, our guides approved us ready for hunting. And as the day was coming to an end, we went to the place called "Sundowner" – a beautiful spot atop a hill with breathtaking surroundings. We met some other fellas there and shared drinks and laughter while telling hunting stories. →

The following day Conway took us on a photo and film safari as we explored the area. As soon as we left the lodge, we started seeing animals, and there were loads of them. So many different species!

The area was massive, and we had covered just a tiny piece of it while driving all day filming and taking numerous photos along the way. There was always something new surprising us and the time flew by. It was surreal seeing all this African wildlife in person for the first time, rather than on television. Early the next morning, we gathered around the breakfast table as the sun was about to rise. Over coffee, our guide told us we would be hunting a mature oryx bull, and we were super stoked about it!

We had seen a group of those beautiful animals while we were on the photo safari. The plan was to drive to the higher peaks, park the Pick-Up, hike up to do some glassing, locate an oryx, and then try to close the distance and make a stalk. Easier said than done. We looked for oryx for three days and hadn't seen the right one. We had spotted a few groups with oryx, but they were females and young males holding together.




The old and mature oryx males, as usual, are not in groups and most of the time they roam alone, making hunting them all the more challenging. Because of this, we had added a mountain zebra to our hunting list and, this particular morning, we left the lodge when it was still dark and drove to the highest peak in the area. We arrived as the sun started to rise and listened to hundreds of bird and animal sounds as nature awakened all around us. An incredible experience!

As the sunlight broke through the sky, we started glassing for animals. From the high peak, we could see vast distances and were able to scan a massive area, but it took a while to spot a few zebras on the horizon. Due to the thick bush and lots of cover, glassing is challenging and animals can appear and disappear very quickly. But this time, the zebras were calmly feeding, and we decide to give it a go.

TAKE YOUR TIME. WHENEVER YOU ARE READY.

Professional hunters knew the area well and the plan was to drive closer and then try to approach them on foot and get within range for the shot. It was not that easy. The ground was incredibly dry, and it was hard to walk quietly. We managed to get close enough to hear them, but the bush was so thick, we couldn't see them. Then the guide found a tiny opening and set the shooting sticks. I aimed but, unfortunately, could only see the zebra's head. The body was still covered by thick bush. Not an ideal shot. As we tried to make an even closer approach, the zebras spooked and disappeared at full speed. We tried to relocate them and eventually spotted them again on the high hills in an open area but making a successful stalk was unlikely, so we decided to leave them and continue our drive. Suddenly the guide spotted another group of mountain zebras. It was almost the same scenario as on the first stalk, only this time the bush was not as thick, and we were able to get within 90 m of them.

A few zebras were behind the tree and another single one was coming from the left and stopped broadside. The guide beside me silently whispered, "Take your time. Whenever you are ready". I fired the 8,5 x 55 Blaser, and there it was. Our very first African game laying on the dry ground. It was a challenging and intense hunt, and the relief after accomplishing it was immense. →




The following day, after a good rest at the lodge, we went after an impala ram. As luck would have it, we saw a lot of them while hunting or filming other animals, but now that we were pursuing them, they were few and far between. We had been driving around and glassing since early morning and had seen some impala bucks, but they were too young to take out. We also spooked an eagle and saw his prey hanging in the tree. It was a young steenbock. A nice encounter and a reminder of the balance and life cycle in nature. As the heat started to pick up, we headed back to the lodge but on the way back, we stopped to check one last spot. It was a small rocky hill and when we reached the peak, there were four nice impala rams feeding right below us. Completely unexpected!

The adrenaline rush kicked in, our hearts were pounding, and everything seemed to be happening so fast. In situations like this, it's important to not rush the shot. Luckily the rams kept feeding and didn't see or hear us due to the strong wind. We had time to get into position for the shot. This time it was 150m downhill in high wind, but it all came together, and the ram dropped in our sight. Once again, our trusty 8,5x55 did a great job.



On the last day of our hunt, we decided to take it easy and didn't drive too far from the lodge. This time we were after springbok. We had seen hundreds of them during our time here and were looking for a decent buck. We made several stalks but unsuccessfully. They were in bigger groups, and it was not easy to trick so many eyes and noses. In the distance, we spotted a single buck bedding down in an open field. His head was facing the opposite direction making him perfect for approach. It took a while, but we slowly closed the distance. It was only when the rifle was already on the shooting sticks that the buck felt something was not right and stood up looking at us. But it was too late for him, and the rest is history. We still couldn't believe that it all came together but the professional guides and teamwork paid off. What a great way to end the hunt.

Back at the lodge by the dinner table, we shared some hunting stories. It was sad to leave after such a great week spending time at the luxurious Blaser Sney Rivier for the very first time. This experience totally changed our minds and understanding of conservation and hunting here.

We thought it would be easy – almost too easy – but hunting here is far from it. The best way to understand is, to experience it.







The hunting season for all four ibex species runs from October to the end of May. Hunting during the rut from the middle of November to the middle of December is highly recommended, or from April when bucks group together in small packs.

Along with ibex, Spain also offers opportunities for combined hunts, having good stocks of red and fallow deer, chamois and aoudad sheep in its various regions.





FINLAND

Hunting among Friends



In Finland you find a beautiful landscape and very friendly people.



Finland offers the hunts for whitetail, moose, grouse species like black grouse as well as capercaillie.



Whitetails are mostly hunted from the high seat. This can last until the late evening and is a unique experience – especially in the snow! Hunting moose takes place individually on the high seat or as a driven hunt: You may hunt bulls, cows and calves. The traditional nordic hunt for grouse species in the snow is hunting them in the treetops with the help of elk-hounds – either with a snowmobile or on skis.
